SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. PRE-ENTRY DEADLINES

A horse must be entered in at least one class to be considered “pre-entered”

2. “ALL-SHOW” FEE

- Applies to PRE-ENTRIES ONLY
- (One) HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION

3. “Mail-In” Paper Entries: Submission Deadline **April 24, 2010** postmark

- Payment in full or an open check must accompany all entries
- Current NEGATIVE Coggins Certificate
- Proof of age for horses entering age specified classes

4. “On-Line” Entries: Submission Deadline **April 29, 2010** –

www.showhorsemanagement.com

- Printed confirmation of on-line submission
- Payment in full or by open check prior to receiving entry package in show office
- Current NEGATIVE Coggins
- Proof of age for horses entering age specified classes

5. “Dressage” Entries: Submission Deadline **April 29, 2010** (Paper or On-line)

- Dressage times will be assigned and available at <http://www.ipass.net/cmesc/>.

6. “Late” Entries: Applies to all horse entries received after deadlines

- Late registration fee of \$20 applies per horse
- Post-entry fee of \$15 per class

7. CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: A horse must be entered in at least one qualifying class to enter Championship classes. Please contact Show Manager with any questions concerning qualifying classes

8. All adult exhibitors in Amateur or AOT classes must have a current Amateur exhibitor card. Exhibitor cards are optional for Youth Exhibitors and Country Pleasure Exhibitors. Exhibitor cards are provided free of charge with NWA membership. In lieu of purchasing a membership, exhibitors can opt to purchase a Temporary Show Card for a single event or a Seasonal Show Card good for one year.

9. **CURRENT 12 MO. NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED ON ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS—INCLUDES HORSES 6 MO. & OLDER. PAPERS MUST BE DISPLAYED IN THE PLASTIC ENVELOPE AT EACH STALL. DO NOT COME WITHOUT COGGINS!!! STATE VET WILL BE ON THE GROUNDS CHECKING COGGINS.**

10. **STALL FEES: \$50.00 per stall for show or \$35.00 per stall per day.** Stalls will be ready for use Thursday morning and must be vacated Sunday morning unless prior arrangements have been made with the show manager. Stall assignments are on a first-come first-serve basis. Special requests should be noted on entry sheets. Anyone wishing to be stalled together should note on their entries who they would like to be stalled with and if at all possible mail all entries together. **Please leave your name and phone number where you may be reached during the show on your stall so show officials may get in contact with you should there be a problem with your horse or in case of emergencies.**

11. **GROUND FEES:** \$10 per horse per day. Applies to all horses on the grounds who do not have paid stalls.

12. **HORSE SHOW OFFICE** will close entries 30 minutes prior to scheduled starting time of each session. Classes not added before this time will be charged a \$10 POST-entry fee EACH. Scratches accepted at any time; however, entry fee will NOT be refunded unless scratched 30 minutes before session starts. Please be considerate of other participants. Scratch or add classes early to avoid gate delays and extra fees.
13. **REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES AND STALLS FEES** will only be made minus a \$10 office charge per horse upon request before the closing date. After the closing date, refunds will be made upon presentation of certificate issued by a veterinarian on official letterhead stating illness or lameness before the start of the show. Entry fees will be refunded minus a \$10 office charge per horse. Entry fees may be transferred to a substitute horse or rider if necessary.
14. No splitting of Class fees, stall fees, etc. on entry forms. If you need to split costs within your group, please arrange this among yourselves and prior to settling your accounts in the show office.
15. **PPWHANC** will not be liable for any accident, loss, damage or injury that may occur to an Exhibitor, Owner, Trainer, Agent, Groom, Individual or Spectator sustained while at the Tarheel Plantation Classic Horse Show. This shall be incorporated as a condition of entry or admittance to the Show.
16. **The Tarheel Plantation Classic Show Committee** reserves the right to itself of declining to receive any Exhibitor and/or horse to show and the right to order from the grounds any Exhibitor, horse or groom without penalty of compensation.
17. **THIS SHOW IS FOR SOUND WALKING HORSES AND SPOTTED SADDLE HORSES ONLY. ANY LAME OR SORED HORSES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM COMPETITION IN THE SHOW—NO QUESTIONS ASKED AND FORFIET ALL ENTRY FEES and STALL FEES. ALL HORSES WILL BE CHECKED BY THE DQP BEFORE EACH CLASS AND THE FIRST PLACE HORSE WILL BE CHECKED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE CLASS.**
18. Persons on federal disqualification cannot transport horses to the show and can only participate as a spectator. This is a NWHHA affiliated show and all NWHHA rules will apply.
19. **CAMPER SPACES** with full hook-ups are available on a first-come first-serve basis. **Facility Staff**, not Show Office, is responsible for collecting payments for Camping Spaces.
20. **SHAVINGS:** Each exhibitor is responsible for obtaining and paying Shavings Personnel for their shavings. NO SHAVINGS PROVIDED in any stalls until you make arrangements with Shavings Personnel and make payment to him/her.
21. Please provide all requested information and sign entry blanks in all spaces provided so that back numbers may be given out promptly upon arrival.
22. The Tarheel Plantation Classic Horse Show will follow NWHHA versatility rules.
23. DQP INSPECTION GUIDELINE: All horses must be inspected without tack during both pre- and post-show inspections. No saddles or breast collars will be allowed during inspections. Horses must be led to the inspection area wearing only a halter or bridle. In addition, a horse's shoes may be pulled and hoof testers may be used. If a follow-up testing is needed, thermography will be utilized. In addition to pre- and post-class inspection, a DQP has the right to inspect horses anywhere on the show grounds

Plantation Pleasure

Open to any Walking Horse that is plantation shod. To be shown at a flat walk, running walk and canter where so designated.

Lite Shod

Open to any Walking Horse that is lite shod or barefoot. To be shown at a flat walk, running walk and canter where designated.

Trail Pleasure

Open to any Walking Horse that is lite shod. Cannot cross enter with any other lite shod or plantation shod or country pleasure class at this show. May show halter and versatility.

Country Pleasure Amateur

Open to any lite shod or barefoot horse. May not cross enter with any other Walking Horse division in this show. May show in versatility or miscellaneous classes. May show in English or Western tack but not a combination of the two. Neat attire is accepted. To be shown at a trail walk and a pleasure gait. May be shown with 2 hands.

Youth

Open to any youth who has not reached their 18th birthday as of Jan 1st. of the competition year. Must have a NWA youth membership card or apply for one before showing to receive points in NWA. To be shown at a flat walk, running walk and canter where designated

Spotted Saddle Horse

Open to SSH horses. To be shown in Western tack/attire at a show walk and show gait unless class designated canter.

Halter & Model

Model Mares, Geldings, Stallions, and Youth Classes: Entries shall be led into the ring in a show bridle or show halter. Exhibitors showing TWH's may be English or Western tack. Horses 2 yrs. & up. To be judged on conformation, conditioning and way of going. Youth are not allowed to exhibit stallions.

In-Hand Weanlings or In-Hand Yearlings

Entries shall be led into the ring in a show halter, English or Western. To be judged on conformation, conditioning and way of going.

Showmanship

Entries led into ring in English or Western show halter with no consideration given to horse except for grooming and fitting. Horses must be 2 yrs. or older. Whips prohibited in Western tack.

TWH Over Fences

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR AN ASTM/SEI-APPROVED HELMET during any and all schooling and while showing over fences. Riders will be allowed to walk the jump course on foot 30 minutes prior to the start time. Jumps will be set up for schooling in the outside arena between Barn E and the Covered Arena on Friday and Saturday.

Versatility

NWHA Versatility rules apply.
TWHBEA will accept versatility points from this NWHA show.

Shoe Size Regulations:

- WH:** Lite-Shod Shoe—must not exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide by $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick; caulk no thicker than $\frac{3}{4}$ "; turn back not to exceed 1"
- WH:** Plantation-Shod Shoe—must not exceed 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick, caulk not to exceed 1" turn back
- WH:** Trail Pleasure Shoe—must not exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide by $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick; caulk no thicker than $\frac{3}{4}$ "; turn back not to exceed 1"

Country Pleasure: Not to exceed NWHA Lite-Shod shoe size

SSH: Trail Pleasure Shoe—must not exceed that of a lite-shod shoe. Refer to NWHA Rule Book, Section VIII, Paragraph 3.A.2 for shoe requirements. The turnback shall not exceed one inch, and the shoe must not extend more than $\frac{1}{4}$ inch beyond the hoof at the toe. The shoe is not to extend beyond the bulb of the horse's heel when a perpendicular line is drawn from the bulb of the horse's heel to the ground.

SSH: Lite-Shod Shoe—requirements are the same as the SSH Trail Pleasure requirements

SSH: Keg-Shod Shoe—must not exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide by $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick; caulk must not exceed 1"; thickness not to exceed $\frac{3}{8}$ "

RH: Lite-Shod Shoe— $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide by $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick, caulk no thicker than $\frac{3}{4}$ "

RH: Flat-Shod Shoe—1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick, caulk not to exceed 1"

Post-entry fees: \$15 per class, plus a \$20 late registration fee per horse
- DQP inspection fee \$6 per horse per day
- To receive points for PPWHANC Year-End High Points, you must be a PPWHANC member (adult or youth) prior to the show
- To receive points in the NWHA High Point program, you must be a NWHA member (adult or youth) prior to the show.
